You will admire beautiful typical homes and century old trees along the way between Saubusse and Peyrehorade. Traveling downriver on the Adour you will reach the Aviron Bayonnais club after crossing the Petit-Bayonne neighbourhood which used to be a privateers' lair. You will end this tour on the small river, "ERROBI" in Basque, and cross the fairy landscapes of the Nive. You will be lodging in St Bernard High School in Bayonne, a typical old home from which you may easily visit the whole city. You will spend festive evenings in the casemates inside the Vauban fortifications, and on the last day you will enjoy a closing diner party to the sound of Basques songs. And if the sun shines upon you, you may never leave... or keep coming back!

From Saubusse to Peyrehorade: 29 km, picnic, start at 2.30pm, arrival scheduled at 5.30pm.


## DAY 2

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
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
