

splendid 22 km lake was born in the Loire region, near St Etienne, thanks to the building of the Grangent dam. The tour will take you navigating this peaceful lake within the gorges carved by the Loire river over the course of time, a beautiful natural site listed NATURA 2000. Along the way you will pass by many castles and architectural landmarks as old as the middle ages: Chambles Tour, St Victor Castle, Essalois Caslte. Closer to the water you will discover the villages of Echandes, Révotes, and Camadules (former hermitage), Ste Foy Chapel, and Grangent castle. During the second half of the tour Cornillon castle will be keep vigil over your progress as would an eagle. The tour will end with a friendly outdoor. Keep in mind that a unique site awaits but 10mn away (by car): Le Corbusier in Firminy.
