**02.30PM** Stroll on the Rance

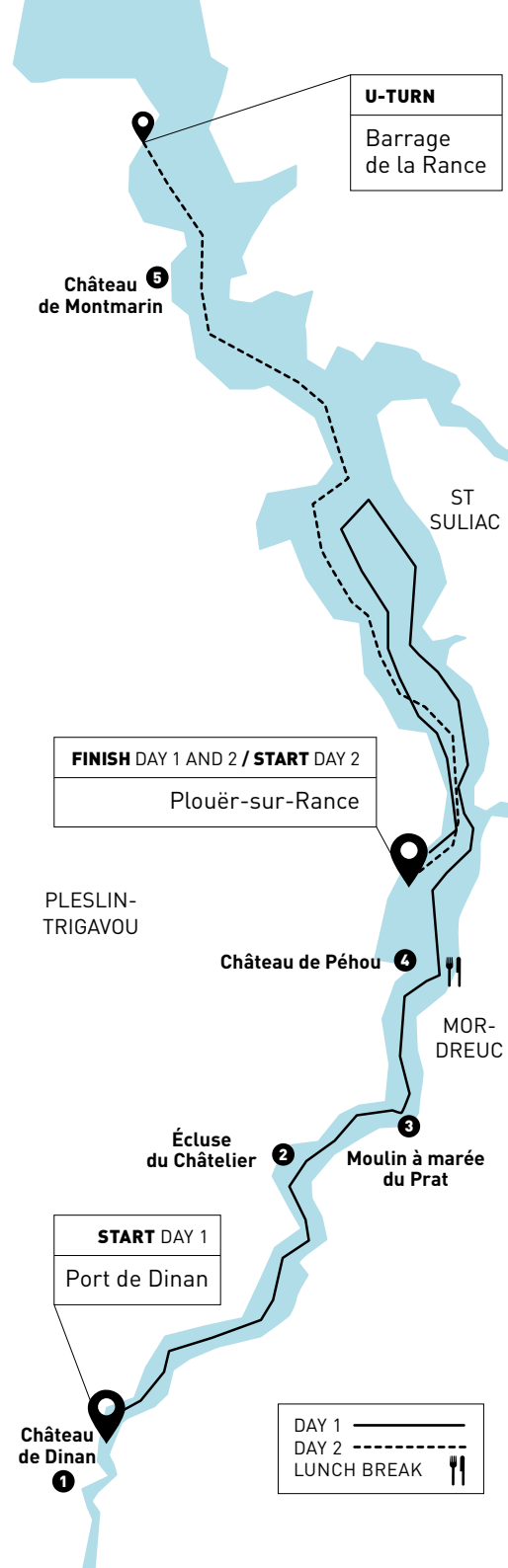
**05.30PM** Boat anchorage

**N**avigating the Rance river from the harbour of Dinan-Lanvallay to Plouër-Sur-Rance, you will pass by a dam, tide mills, and many different structures, from fishermen cabins to castles or typical mansions. You can visit the nearby cities, either the famous "cité corsaire" of St Malo or the medieval town of Dinan. This region has a rich history and heritage, such as its shipyards where were schooners were built and equipped with dories for cod fishing in Newfoundland near Canada. These 20 feet long wooden boats which could be piled up on the schooners for transportation put on quite a show nowadays during the summer races and festival in Saint-Suliac.
