

ocated one hour away in the south of Grenoble, 15 minutes away from La Mure on the Mateysin plateau, the Monteynard lake is an artificial lake, 10 km long and 300 m wide, fuelled by two rivers, the Drac and the Ebron. It is situated in an exceptional natural spot, between Trièves and Mateysine. In this world apart and along the route, you will enjoy a spectacular and always changing mountain scenery – the turquoise water takes you far away...The Himalayan footbridges are unique and stunning from the coxed fours. The Monteynard lake and the region are a local's favourite for a lot of activities, such as windsurfing, kitesurfing, swimming, fishing, hiking, the historic railway line of the Petit Train de La Mure and the Image mine... This tour will allow you to discover our beautiful region.

PROVISIONAL PLANNING

Departure at 8.45 a.m. from the beach to the dam on the right bank, then return via the left bank. The crews will row on the river Ebron to the 1st Himalayan footbridge and join the river Drac to the 2nd Himalayan footbridge and return to the beach after a 30-km tour.

Possibility of returning without going to the 2^{nd} Himalayan footbridge (a 28-km tour).
