At the foot of the national Park des écrins, the Serre-Ponçon Lake, the largest artificial lake in Europe, extends from Embrun city to Ubaye. You will directly start on the shore of the lake, at the Club Nautique Alpin on Chadenas (CNA) in Embrun. You will tour on both shores of the lake and get close to the Saint Michel chapel, a small unavoidable island of the lake. The rowing club of Savines le Lac takes part in the event and welcomes you on the route, before rowing back to the CNA.

PROVISIONAL PLANNING

FROM 7.00 AM lunch and skippers' meeting: safety plan and navigation map on the lake. Selecting the tour, either 20 km or 28 km.

8.30 AM Departure of the tour from the beach of the Club Nautique Alpin, loop around the Saint Michel chapel and optionally (depending on the weather) the tour continues to Chanteloube bay. On the return trip, stop at the club in Savines-le-Lac for a snack.
