

he Celts used to call the Dordogne river "Du Unna", which means "quick waters", but the tour will take you on a quiet segment of the river which winds peacefully between Sainte-Foy and the Castillon coast. The river is wide, calm and a bit sinuous. You will row along vineyards and 18th century old sandcoloured castles. You can complete your journey to the Middle Age with a visit of the famous cities of Saint-Emilion, Sainte-Foy-la-Grande or else Castillon-la-Bataille.
