

The tour takes place in the autumn countryside, along the peaceful and quiet typical meanders of the Marne, the longest French river (525 km). This tour will take you on the discovery of many surprising site, such as Quincangrogne mill, the stone carving site in Dhuys, the Chalifert lock - which you won't cross - the docks used to unload the container ships, Précy village where the famous French singer Barbara used to live, and finally Annet-sur-Marne. You will be stopped halfway by the impassable dam in Trilbardou, then land on the site of the elevatory factory then row up Ourcq canal, which you can visit with a tour guide.


