CHASSELAS TOUR



Moissac, a major site of the Pyrénées, boasts a thousand-year old history. This tour will include the visit of the roman cloister and tympanum of the UNESCO classified Saint-Pierre abbey. You will pass under the Napoleon bridge and navigate the Tarn river in direction of the Ile des Oiseaux natural preserve, located on the Saint Nicolas de la Graves lake. The tour will then continue on the Garonne up until the Malause bridge where you will turn around to come back to the club. The next day, you will head for Saint-Livrade, where you'll enjoy specialties of the region : the Chasselas table grapes and Philibon melons, grown on the hillsides surrounding Moissac.
