

his tour, with three legs during two days along the Basque coast between Biarritz and the Spanish border has been designed for sea-proven rowers in a good physical shape. Two types of landscapes will be offered to participants along the route, the Pyrenean chain, and the Spanish coast, including, in particular, the Txingudi bay in Hendaye and the bay in Saint Jean de Luz, without forgetting their fishing harbours. Viewing the eight beaches between Hendaye and Biarritz will be enhanced by the Domaine d'Abbadia (castle and observatory built for the scientific Antoine d'Abadie), the Fort de Socoa, the typical harbour of Guéthary and the unavoidable Rocher de la Vierge (Virgin Rock, preceding the Hôtel du Palais, a former summer residence built for the Empress Eugénie).

35 km: Departure at 9 a.m. from Socoa towards Biarritz, return, with a picnic stop in Guéthary, then return to the St Jean de Luz Bay.
