

his tour will take you to Metz city and its surroundings through two intertwined routes. Either 25 kms or 57 km for the bolder ones. You will launch on the Jouy canal, which is a green corridor mixing confined spaces and remarkable points of view on the Moselle riverbanks. St Quentin mount and the urbanised areas. You will meet the Moselle at Jouy aux Arches, famous for its roman aqueduct, then row until you reach Pagny-sur-Moselle. You will row on the same river all the journey back to the club then end up on Metz lake where you will discover a surprising view of the city in its natural setting. You will enjoy a lunch break then cross Metz city before turning around in Ars sur Moselle. The tormented route on the Moselle gives way to many arms and canals which will lead you on a discovery of several lakes and islands along both itineraries: Vaux, Jesuit, St Symphorien, Saulcy.


