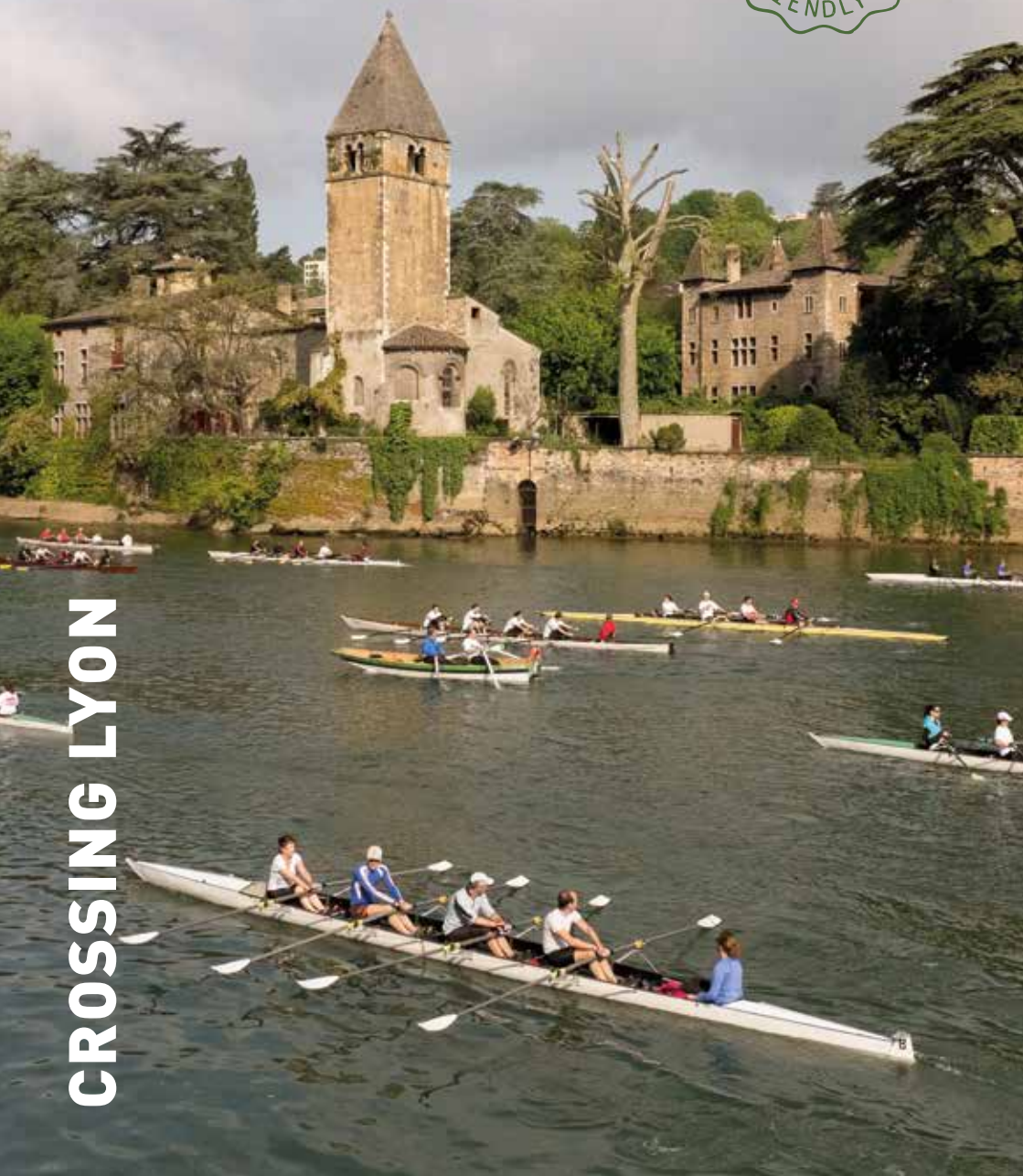

CROSSING LYON



You will start from Barbe island where the 12th century old Notre-Dame chapel stands, and head towards Lyon from the Saône river and then the Rhône. You may admire the steep slopes of Croix Rousse before entering the old city across Saint-Jean neighbourhood and its famous cathedral. You will then reach Notre-Dame de Fourvière basilica which overlooks the Law Court and offers a panoramic view of the whole city. Afterwards, you will pass under the Perrache bridge which marks a fracture between the old town and its industrial area, the "Confluence" neighbourhood which is undergoing a complete renovation and is famous for its stunning architecture. You will go back up the powerful Rhône river until reaching the University bridge and turn around just before the swimming pool built on the riverbank. You may complete your visit of the city by making a stop by the Fresque des Lyonnais, which is part of the UNESCO World Heritage, before strolling along the alleys looking for a typical meal in a local "bouchon lyonnais".
