- Two sea routes in the Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur region, the Cassidaine and the Randonnée du Golfe d'Amour, to explore the calanques and Mediterranean coast;
- The comeback of the Raid des Courreaux de Groix for an adventure in Britanų;
- Modified itineraries to discover new aspects of some iconic routes such as Les Trois Rivières, Les Pertuis Rochelais, Embrun-Lac de Serre-Ponçon, and Les Galères Ligériennes.

For the "Tour of the year", we invite you to the Randonnée Nautique des Gorges de la Loire, where the preserved landscapes will delight nature lovers.

Beyond the sporting fun and the touristic discovery, I also encourage you, through each of these events, to participate in the preservation of aquatic ecosystems, adopting a water-friendly practice, whether you have the chance to row on rivers, lakes or seas.

DETAILED CHARACTERISTICS

AUTONOMOUS ROWER

The rower has the technical knowledge but is not trained.



The rower already has at least one year of regular practice.



The rower has more than one year of regular practice several times a week.

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TOUR OF THE YEAR

Throughout the years a community came to life around these tours, mainly composed of the participants and the organizers. However, there are few opportunities for the participants to gather on a national level and share their passion and experience. That is why the French Rowing Federation decided to nominate a « Tour of the Year », which will reward the tour which stands as the flagship event in France.



GOALS

- · Creating a national yearly event around rowing tours.
- Federating all the actors taking part in these events (members, organizing clubs, federation representatives, suppliers, public or private partners, waterway users...).
- · HighLighting a tour which offers an ambitious project on the reference year.
- Promoting rowing tours thanks to country wide communication throughout the year.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- · Meeting the criteria required for the "Randon'Aviron" label.
- · Organizing a two-day event at least including a festive evening.
- Using a local or regional traditional event to make this tour a special one.
- Proposing other sport activities complementary to the tour (hiking, canoe, roller or horse riding, biking...) so as to bring together other participants and companions.
- Creating a village for tour participants: rowing gear stands, local products, advertising other tours and tourist activities, events, debates...
- Organizing a sustainable event thanks to the « Sustainable Event » tool provided by the Rowing Federation.



The event designated as the "Tour of the year" in 2025 is the Randonnée Nautique des Gorges de la Loire, organized by the Aviron Stéphanois club on June 14th and 15th. This event is one of the oldest on the Randon'Aviron circuit and will celebrate its 30th anniversary.

On this occasion, the club invites you to an in-depth rediscovery of the history of the Loire riverbanks and offers festivities worthy of this milestone. With about 40 km located in a Natura 2000 area, you will be enchanted by the rich biodiversity and heritage.

Grab your oars to explore this corner of France, which is too often unknown to the wider public!

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TOUR CHART

Organizing a tour implies setting up a few ground rules in order to make sure the tour is as safe as possible. Organizers selected to be part of this guide have to make sure they respect the required criteria hereunder. In exchange the participants are supposed to be aware of the characteristics of the tour they choose, and to comply with the related conditions.

THE ROWERS' COMMITMENT

The rower guarantees:

- · He can swim.
- He is fit and has enough rowing experience to complete the tour. (you must at least own the rowing diploma of level 2 and/or a crew half-marathon stamina diploma).
- He has a valid FFA license. Foreign rowers who practice abroad and are member of a foreign rowing club will be required to prove they are covered by public liability insurance. Any competition required both a license and medical certificate.
- He will respect the applicable navigating codes and any rule enforced by the organizers.

Aboard each boat:

- Each rower must have a safety vest available.
- •The crew has bailers and a 10m long and 10mm wide cord onboard so as to ensure docking or towing if needed. Depending on the tour, boathook and compass may be required.
- •The crew must pick a skeeper :
- •The skipper must be a qualified adult. He will be responsible for the crew' safety and the respect of navigating rules and regulations.
- He must know the tour schedule and the safety regulations. He should attend possible meetings.
- •He must check the equipment before departure, and make sure its team members have enough experience.

THE ORGANIZER COMMITMENT

The tour organizer is a FFA member.

He guarantees:

- · He has all the required administrative licenses.
- Must have checked that all the equipment and facilities, either fixed or movable in use are insured.
- He will set up and ensure the required logistics and safety throughout the whole tour, in agreement with the local authorities (river police, maritime affairs...).
- He will send to the participants a detailed program of the tour with specific requirements: description of the tour (sea, river, length...), equipment (boat tupe), as well as possible adjustments to be made on the boats.
- He will warn the participants about the schedule and characteristics of the tour, and remind them the safety rules. This information must be given to skippers before departure.
- He must post and remind participants of the information regarding the tour, such as the presence of safety boats.
- For tours taking place on rivers, lakes or sea, as for canals with locks, a minimum of safety boats is required according to the number of participants (FFA ratio).
- On narrow canals without any locks to pass (or passed by portage), mobile security can be ensured from the bank



10 SIMPLE RULES FOR YOUR SAFETY

- **01** Before departing, always check your boat and the equipment inside it (bailers, rope, gaff, etc.).
- 02 Get acquainted with the tour and its characteristics.
- 03 Respect the navigating codes and don't forget:
 - Usually one navigates on the right side of channels (same as on the road).
 - · Sailing and trading boats have priority.
 - · Navigating is forbidden at night or by foggy weather.
- **04** Be careful when approaching dams and make sure to respect organizers' instructions in order to pass locks.
- **05** When you wander on the coastal path, think about other strollers.
- **06** Often take time to evaluate the current' strength and the water's depth, which may vary from one section to another.
- 07 Embark and disembark against the current or prevailing wind. Make sure your steersman is equipped with a paddle so he can maneuver whenever the oars are inside the boat.
- 08 If you come across a boat which makes waves, and your boat is not self-emptying, make sure to position yourself parallel to the wave in order to limit the water entry.
- O9 If you don't have a steersman, make sure to turn around frequently.
- 10 Never lose sight of the other boats.



«Voies Navigables de France» (VNF) is a public establishment which is in charge of managing the best part of the French river network which represents b 700 km of rivers and canals, about 4000 struces (locks, dams...), and around 40 000 hectares of river state property. Rowers may practice on these rivers and cross these structures, which are sometimes part of the local tourist attractions. a Voies Navigables de France» and the French Rowing Federation work together in developing rowing and rowing tours, while raising rowers' awareness for rivers respect and protection.

Through the organization of rowing tour we take part in developing tourism in our country and help promoting the use of rivers.
